STILLWATER BECOMES THE FIRST IN THE STATE TO START A BIGS IN BLUE PROGRAM

Bigs in Blue is a national initiative aimed at matching Littles with Bigs in law enforcement. Many of the children we serve have had negative interactions with or have negative perceptions about law enforcement. We believe that by partnering with law enforcement, we are taking a crucial step in changing those perceptions and defending the potential of the Littles in the Stillwater community.

Oklahoma's first Bigs in Blue match is between Stillwater Police Officer and Resource Board Member Sherae LeJeune and Little Sister Jennifer. Through our partnership with Stillwater PD, Sherae is able to visit Jennifer as a part of our Site-Based program while she is on duty.

Little Sister Jennifer told us in a recent match support visit that **Sherae is the first person who has ever talked to her about attending college.** Jennifer is now excited about college because of the encouragement and insight she received from a conversation with her Big!
